

## The Panasonic Bread Cutter



There are jillions of Panasonic bread makers populating the earth. They make a loaf of bread with a very consistent width. However, using an ordinary cutting board it is difficult to cut straight consistent slices.

The bread cutting board shown on the right matches the width of a Panasonic loaf exactly so that the loaf is held securely while being cut.



The pusher with the knob is used when the loaf gets small.



The photo on the upper right shows a vertical panel on the right that is used to control the thickness of the slice. This panel has been removed in the photo on the left so that you can see the knife positioned in the cutting guide. When the panel is in place the loaf can be pressed up against it so that a uniform slice thickness is always achieved.
